| Much beloved by the UK market, Bollinger is a heavier style of Champagne with nice fruit and some complexity. | |
| 2. MOET ET CHANDON, "Brut Imperial" N/V | £75.00 |
| With one of the most significant legacies to the Champagne business, Moet leads from the front with this consistently elegant, bright Champagne. Well balanced and rounded with light citrus notes coupled with subtle brioche notes leads through to crisp finish | |
| 3. PROSECCO PASSAPAROLA, Pradio | £26.00 |
| This classic from the North of Italy is a delicious sparkler with aromatic pear flavours on the nose followed by a crisp palate of succulent apple and pear. Gently foamy, with a crisp and delicate finish, drink on its own or in true Venetian style, as a Bellini. | |

- 4. CHARDONNAY, Costa Vera (Chile)** **£18.50**
A crisp, unwooded style of Chardonnay with lively lemony fruit character and refreshing pear and apple finish.
- 5. SAUVIGNON BLANC RESERVA, Nostros (Chile)** **£19.50**
Sourced from Chile's premium Sauvignon Blanc region, Casablanca, this is a pure, exuberantly fruity Sauvignon packed full of grassy, tropical fruit. Instantly refreshing and moreish with a lovely tangy finish.
- 6. RIOJA JOVEN BLANCO, Luis Canas (Spain)** **£22.00**
A youthful, vibrantly crisp white made from Rioja's Viura grape variety. Attractive, lemon character with a well rounded finish of melon and pineapple.
- 7. PINOT GRIGIO, Uvam (Italy)** **£23.00**
On the palate there's an abundance of tropical fruit, melon, Guava and peach supported by zippy acidity making it mouth-tinglingly moreish
- 8. CHARDONNAY, 'The Great Escape', Thistledown (Australia)** **£24.00**
An inviting nose of peach and melon leads to beautifully restrained tropical fruit palate with a refreshing lick of crisp acid to leave you wanting more.
- 9. GRUNER VELTLINER, Federspiel Terrassen, (Austria)** **£25.00**
A perfect and versatile food wine. Delicious, marked white pepper, grapefruit and citrus aromas, elegant and long on the palate.
- 10. SAUVIGNON BLANC, Sherwood (New Zealand)** **£27.00**
New Zealand provides us with the world's most characteristic flavours. Ripe, tropical fruit mingles with racy, gooseberry and asparagus hints.

A vivid, bright pink with all the ripe, succulent fruit one would expect. Soft, well rounded and oh so gluggable, this is the perfect accompaniment to long sunny days - or the perfect refuge from long wet days!

- 13. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Costa Vera (Chile)** **£18.50**
Deliciously cherry filled and exuberant with ripe plummy fruit and hints of cassis and chocolate.
- 14. SHIRAZ/CABERNET SAUVIGNON, "The Wrong Un"
One Chain Vineyards (Australia)** **£18.90**
A rich, well balanced example of the Aussie classic blend. Lush black fruits coupled with touches of woodspice, liquorice and cassis follow through to a delicious, velvety finish.
- 15. MERLOT, Largesse, Vin de Pays d'Oc (France)** **£19.50**
A juicy, succulent red brimming with ripe blackberry and plum fruit. Supple, fleshy and well rounded on the palate with a smooth, long finish.
- 16. MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO, Altopiano (Italy)** **£19.50**
Small red berry fruits, wild cherry, violets, delicate and spicy. Full bodied, well structured with soft tannins.
- 17. MALBEC, Santa Rosa (Argentina)** **£21.00**
Quickly becoming the most important red for Argentina, this Bordeaux export produces full, robust wines with deep plummy fruit, structured tannins and good length.

- 18. OLD VINE GARNACHA, La Multa, El Escoces Volante (Spain)** **£22.00**
There aren't many Scotsmen making wine in Calatayud but Norrel Robertson MW is a bit of a maverick! Punching well above its weight, Norrel's Garnacha made from gnarly old vines is rich, concentrated but well balanced with huge, ripe berry fruit, lots of spice and sweet oak and long rich finish.
- 19. PINOT NOIR, Sherwood (New Zealand)** **£27.00**
Sourced from different vineyard sites exclusively for Sherwood, the wine is vinified separately and then aged in oak. Vibrant colours, cherry and plum character. Medium bodied.
- 20. SHIRAZ, 'The Basket Case' Thistledown (Australia)** **£28.00**
Glossy, soft and perfumed with lush black fruits and a creamy, liquoricey palate.
- 21. RIOJA RESERVA, Luis Canas (Spain)** **£32.00**
Produced from the finest vintages, Luis Canas Reserva is aged in oak to give a mellow but complex and full flavoured red.
- 22. CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE, "Bel Ami Rouge", Guillaume Gonnet (France)** **£42.00**
A red and black fruit bouquet, of cherries and blackberries, a hint of garrigue, liquorice and spice. A fine wine.
